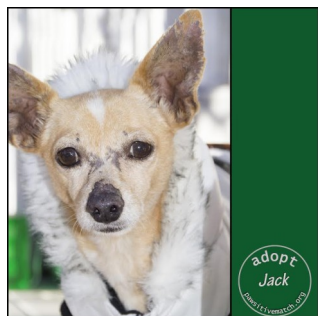
5 NEW YEAR RESOLUTIONS TO HELP PMRF DOGS!

DOG OF THE MONTH GRACIE

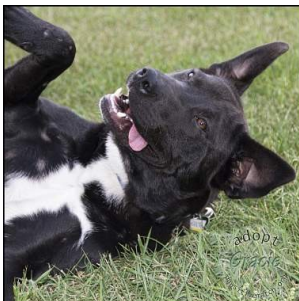
**** GRACIE CURRENTLY NEEDS BOTH A FOSTER AND ADOPTIVE HOME ****

HAPPY TAILS

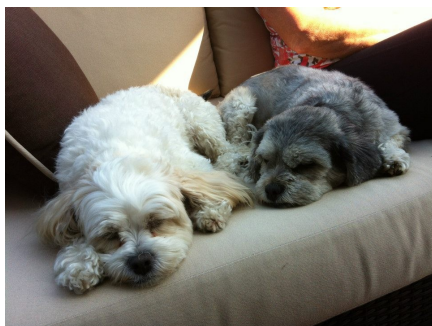
BOBBY
